This special event will feature an extended vendor selection and craft show, among other festive fall activities. The kitchen will be heating up to serve guests delicious pizzas out of the professional wood-fired oven for just \$12 each. Guests will also have the opportunity to taste a different side of the Market with a hard cider tasting alongside live music performed by Alter of Stone. Take part in the 50/50 raffle to win big before the upcoming holiday season, or try your hand at the pumpkin carving contest hosted by the Frankenmuth Jaycees.

This year has been a year unlike any other, but the Frankenmuth Farmers Market has persevered, altering their rental options to better serve guests and allow for social distancing, creating signage to guide guests while visiting the market, as well as creating opportunities during the Stay Safer at Home order that allowed the community to still enjoy locally-sourced, fresh produce. The Market has hosted more than 75 unique local vendors throughout the entire market season, which runs from mid-May to mid-October, and welcomed over 5000 guests to their market days.
