Did you know that if you are standing on Main Street, you are never more than one mile away from a scenic park or a body of water? In Frankenmuth, you can find nature tucked away in every corner!

RIVER WALK Visitors to Frankenmuth over the past few years have likely noticed the changes along our riverfront. A protective levee and riverwalk along the scenic Cass River are scheduled for completion by summer of 2021. Guests will be able to stroll along the riverside from the west portion of Gunzenhausen Street all the way to White House Boutique. The path will be ADA accessible, allowing it to be enjoyed by all guests.

PADDLE POWER While enjoying the new riverwalk, visitors may notice kayakers floating down the river. You can take part yourself! Paddle on your own by renting from Frankenmuth Kayak Adventures and pick your own trip.

WINE NOT? If you'd rather "wine" down while on the water, take a ride on the Frankenmuth FunShips. This relaxing tour takes you on an hour-long ride on a quaint electric boat while you sample Michigan wines and handmade chocolates. At the end of the ride, pick your favorite wine and enjoy a full glass!

A SCENIC RIDE Bavarian Belle Riverboat provides another waterside adventure for those looking to learn some history and embrace the scenic side of Frankenmuth. As you cruise along the river, the narrated tour gives you a little insight into the sights and history of Michigan's Little Bavaria.

ZIP! Would you believe a zipline park lies just beyond the trees in Frankenmuth? If sticking to dry land is more your style, look no further than Frankenmuth Aerial Park. This high-flying adventure will have you climbing through obstacles on six different courses ranging in difficulty from beginner to expert.
